

Color Changing Flowers

Step 1: trim your flower stems at an angle

Step 2: fill each vessel halfway with water

Step 3: place 5-10 drops of food coloring in each vessel

Step 4: wait a couple of days as your flowers turn colors!

What is happening here?

Flowers need water to survive, just like humans! Flowers "drink" water up through their stems. The water travels through a process called capillary action. With the dye in the water, you are able to watch capillary action - in action!

Materials:

- white flowers (of any kind)
- vessel
- food coloring
